

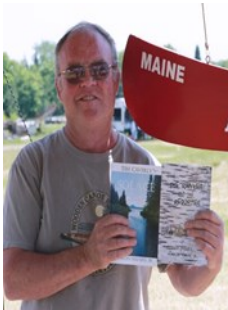

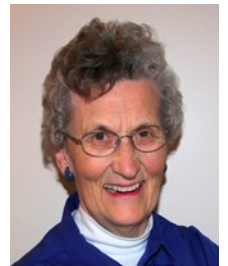

Tim and his friend Frank Manzo Jr. have donated over 1,750 *Allagash Tail's* books to 144 New England schools. Tim has lived in the four corners of Maine and his stories are based on personal experiences and knowledge of our state's history and landscapes.
